

Equal Marriage Questionnaire

1. Do you support or oppose the following advisory referendum that the Illinois "Family" Institute attempted to place on Illinois' November 7, 2006 general election ballot:

"To secure and preserve the benefits of marriage for our society and for future generations of children, a marriage between a man and a woman is the **only legal union** that shall be valid or recognized in this state."

Note: If this wording were added to the Illinois constitution it would not only prevent any same-sex civil union or marriage but also threaten existing benefits such as bereavement leave, hospital visitation rights, or health care benefits for domestic partners.
